Майже вся територія країни підходить для вітроенергетики, адже середньорічна швидкість вітру на більшості території сягає 7-8 м/с, що є дуже сприятливим показником. Окрім того, Україна має перспективи для розвитку офшорної вітрової енергетики, зокрема у водах Чорного та Азовського морів, коли це стане можливим з безпекової точки зору».


За словами Верещинської з початку повномасштабної війни українські вітроенергетики активізували дослідження потенціалу західних і центральних областей країни, а саме таких перспективних регіонів з точки зору вітрового ресурсу, як Житомирська, Вінницька, Волинська, Рівненська та Львівська області, де середня швидкість вітру може сягати 6,5-7,0 м/с.





